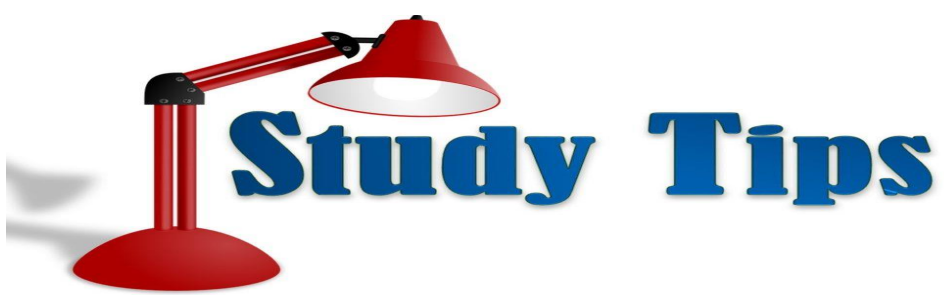

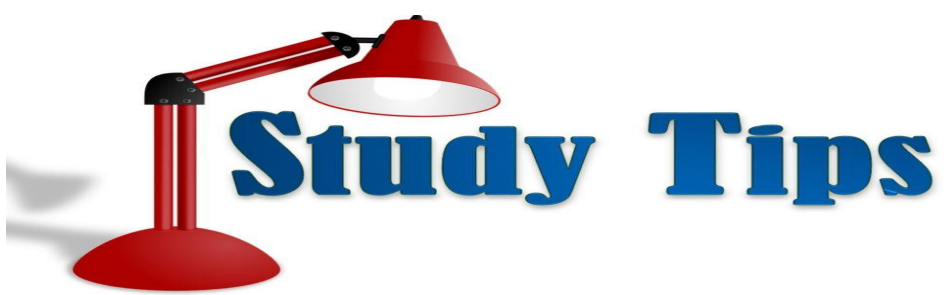


# Study tip #1
