

Right Speech - do not say things to hurt others, be kind.

Right Action - Take care of life - don't destroy it.

Right Livelihood – earn a living (do jobs) without hurting others.

Right Effort – make the effort to do what is right.

Right Mindfulness – be aware of your actions, words and thoughts **Right Concentration** – learn to meditate without losing focus or concentration
