Musicals

<u>Musical</u> – A performance that combines song, spoken dialogue, acting and dance.

Matilda – Based on the 1988 novel by Roald Dahl, narrative centres on Matilda, a precocious 5-year-old girl with the gift of telekinesis, who loves reading and overcomes obstacles caused by her family and school.

<u>Wicked</u> – It is based on the novel by Winnie Holzman, based in the land of Oz before and after Dorothy arrives, where 2 unlikely witches become friends.

We Will Rock You — Centred around the music by Queen, the musical tells the story of a group of Bohemians who struggle to restore freedom and live music in a distant future where everyone acts the same.

Components of Dance

<u>Actions</u> – The movements the body makes. The basic dance actions are, jumping, turning, traveling, gesture, stillness/balance.

<u>Unison</u> – A group of 2 people or more performing the same movement at the same time altogether

<u>Dynamics</u> – HOW you do a movement, the quality of an action: slow, sharp, gentle, robotic

<u>Contact</u> - Making contact with someone in your group, such as a lift, pull, push.

<u>Levels</u> - Having a variety of height in your movements or phrase
