Key Words	Meaning
Aspiration	a hope or ambition of achieving something
Career	an occupation undertaken for a significant period of a person's life and with opportunities for progress.
College	An educational option for after you turn 16
Teamwork	Working together towards a common goal
Enterprise	a project or undertaking, especially a bold or complex one
Skills	a particular ability that you develop through training and experience and that is useful in a job:
Raising Aspirations	To challenge ourselves by aiming high and setting goals that aren't too easy.
Communication	To talk and listen in order to achieve something together.



Future/Dreaming	Imagination Sets goals for the future but does not put forth the effort to reach those goals.	Aspirations Sets goals for the future and puts forth the effort in the present to reach those goals.
	Hibernation Has no goals for the future and puts forth no effort in the present.	Perspiration Works hard in the present but has no goals for the future.
