Key Words	Meaning
Extremism	The holding of extreme political or religious views
Radicalisation	The process by which someone comes to support, or take part in acts of terrorism, or extremist views.
Internet Subcultures	A subculture that either formed on, or uses the internet as its primary method of communication.
Misogyny	An ingrained prejudice against women.
The Far Right	A political ideology of people who are ultra-nationalistic, anti-immigration and concerned about multi-culturalism.
Radical Islam	The UK government characterises Radical Islam as "any form of Islam that opposes Democracy and Respect and Tolerance for the beliefs of others"
Islamophobia	An ingrained prejudice for Muslims.
Anti-Semitism	An ingrained prejudice for Jewish people.
