Identity	The different factors and aspects that make you, you.
Diversity	The condition of being composed of different elements. For example, diversity in
	a society means that the people in the community are from different ethnic and
	cultural backgrounds.
Equality	The practice of ensuring equal treatment regardless of a person's protected
	characteristics.
Discrimination	Treating some people differently than others based on their background, culture,
	race, sexuality or other protected characteristics.
Protected	It is illegal to discriminate against someone on the basis of the following
Characteristics	characteristics:
	Age, Race, Sex, Gender Reassignment, Religion or Belief, Marriage/ Civil
	Partnership, Pregnancy and maternity, Sexual Orientation
Tolerance	The ability to tolerate the existence of opinions or behaviours that you disagree
	with.
Intolerance	Unwillingness to accept views or beliefs that differ from your own
Prejudice	Judging someone based on your idea of them before getting to know them
