
Unit 3 - Discrimination

Key Words Meaning Identity The different factors and aspects that make you, you. The condition of being composed of different elements. For example, diversity in **Diversity** a society means that the people in the community are from different ethnic and cultural backgrounds. Equality The practice of ensuring equal treatment regardless of a person's protected characteristics. Discrimination Treating some people differently than others based on their background, culture, race, sexuality or other protected characteristics. Gender Describes how a person feels about their gender. Identity **Cis-Gender** Describes a person who identifies as the gender that they were born with Trans-Gender Describes a person who identifies as a different gender to their biological sex. A man attracted to other men Gay A woman attracted to other women Lesbian

Bi Sexual A person who is romantically attracted to members of both biological sexes.
