


Terminology

<u>Media Experimentation</u> – using a variety of materials and techniques for different purposes to create different effects and outcomes.

<u>Annotation</u> – Should support your thinking and understanding of what you have done. You should include technical information, WWW & EBI.

<u>Thumbnails</u> – Thumbnails are small sketches of your ideas, inspired by your sources and starting points. They should be annotated to explain thinking

Artist Study – A page with information about a arist and their work, your opinions of their work and a copy of one of their pieces.

Assessment Objectives

<u>AO1</u> – Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources. E.g. photographers, trips or other sources of inspiration.

AO2 – Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes.

AO3 – Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses. E.g. lighting plans and annotations.

<u>AO4</u> - Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language.
