Photographic Terms

Manipulation – the transformation or alteration of a photograph using physical or digital methods and techniques to achieve desired results.

<u>Annotation</u> – Should support your thinking and understanding of what you have done. You should include technical information, WWW & EBI.

<u>Contact Sheet</u> – Thumbnails of all the photographs you have taken on a photoshoot.

Annotated to support what you have done and why.

Photographer Study – A page with information about a photographer and their work, examples of their photography and your opinions of it.

Assessment Objectives

<u>AO1</u> – Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources. E.g. photographers, trips or other sources of inspiration.
