## Subject Specific Terminology.

- Intertextuality: Links to other popular media by the way of dress, narrative or design.
- Narrative: the stories created by images and text (could be linked to Roland Barthes' enigma codes).
- Stereotyping: Using images to create meaning e.g: women fighting / men leading
- **Mise-En-Scene:** how everything in the scene is created for a meaning. The purpose of the images and text.
- **Documentary:** A form of non-fiction film that documents the real world.
- **Concept:** A type of music video whereby the video is not just a performance.
