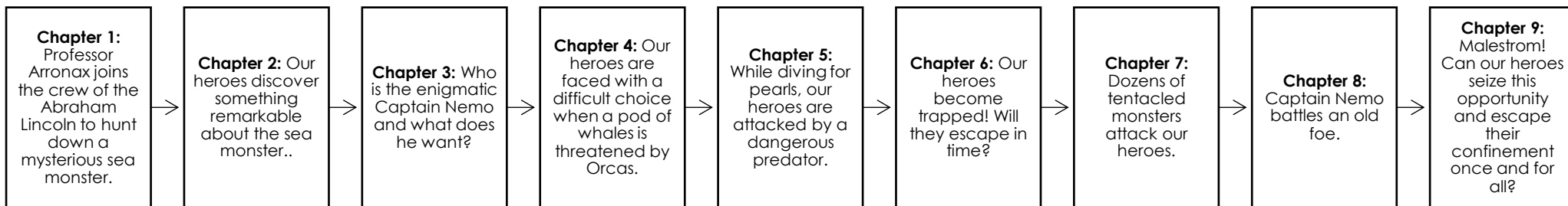
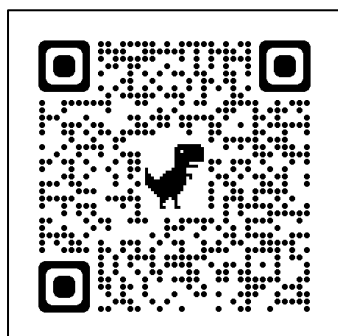


Y7. Spring Term. *Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea* by Jules Verne. Knowledge Organiser



- Characterisation** – the creation of a fictional character
- Dilemma** – a situation where a difficult choice has to be made
- Discovery** – something that is found unexpectedly
- Explicit** – stated clearly with no room for doubt
- Exploration** – travelling somewhere new and finding out about it
- Implicit** – suggested, not directly stated
- League** – a unit of measurement, approximately 3 miles
- Maelstrom** – a powerful whirlpool
- Narrative Hook** – used by writers at the beginning of stories to engage their readers
- Natural History** – the scientific study of animals and plants
- Ocean** – a very large expanse of sea
- Submarine** – a vessel capable of travelling underwater
- Tension** – emotional strain
- Theme** – an idea explored by a writer

Conseil – Arronax's loyal assistant and friend.

Ned Land – A famous whale hunter.

Captain Nemo – The mysterious captain of the Nautilus.
