- Doesn't sexualise the person
- Makes the person feel happy
- Said in a safe space

Sexual Harassment

- X Shouted across the street
- Makes the person feel intimidated
- × Referring to body parts
- Comments of a sexual nature
- Approached in a place they don't feel safe or unable to leave

| Meaning | Toxic Relationship Behaviours |

| Persuading someone to do something by force or threats | Coercion |
| When someone faces physical pressure to marry someone. | Forced Marriage |
| Behaviour that demeans or humiliates someone | Harassment |
| Coercive and violent behaviour by someone in a close relationship, such as parent, partner, or ex partner. | Domestic Abuse |
| The act of being unfaithful to a spouse or other partner. | Infidelity |



| Key Words | Meaning |

| Sexual Harassment | Any unwanted sexual behaviour that makes someone feel upset, scared or humiliated. |
| Sexual Violence | Forcing or manipulating someone else into sexual activity |
| Upskirting | Taking photos underneath a persons clothes without their permission |
| Freedom to consent | Saying "yes" without pressure, coercion or threats |
| Capacity to consent | Having a clear fully formed understanding of the choice that is being made. |
