Dance students attend Move It dance convention



A reminder about school uniform expectations

Thank you to those who support us in ensuring your child comes to school in full and well-presented uniform. Maintaining consistency in our expectation of how our students present themselves helps develop the sense of pride our students have in coming to our school.

Mobile Phones

We have a 'See it, Lose it" mobile phone policy at The Portsmouth Academy. It is essential the phones of every student are stored in their bags and switched off when they arrive at the school gates. Phones are not to be out during the school day, at any time. If a mobile phone is seen students will be asked to hand over their phones. All phones confiscated will be stored securely. Phones are returned to students at the end of the day. If students refuse to follow instructions from staff, they will be placed in the removal room. Entry to the removal room also requires students to hand over their phones. If students refuse to comply, they will be at risk of a suspension from school. If you need to contact your child in a rare emergency, please contact the school reception.
