Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Year 7 GL Assessments

During the week commencing Monday 11th September, Year 7 students will sit their GL Assessments in English, Maths and Science, as well as completing PASS and CAT4 tests.

GL Assessments not only inform us of each student's progress this academic year, but they inform class arrangements and lesson planning for the upcoming academic year.

To develop good habits for future GCSE examinations, the GL Assessments will take place in the Sports Hall under examination conditions. These exams are completed online and questions/instructions are read to the students throughout the assessment, therefore, students will need their device fully charged and a set of headphones each day, this is the student's responsibility.

Please see the GL Assessment schedule below. For the vast majority of the week students will only sit one assessment each day and will be informed of the rules and schedule during an upcoming tutor time/presentation (schedule seen below). Should a student miss their exam they will catch up on another day. Should a student fail to follow examination rules, they will recomplete the assessment during a 60-minute detention the following week.

Information for Students:

For every assessment that you have, you are to go to the Dining Hall and line up in alphabetical order in your class, when silent you will be taken into the Sports Hall to leave your belongings at the back of the Hall and take your seat.



Rules:

- Enter the Sports Hall and complete the assessments in silence.
- Mobile phones and smart watches should be switched off and left in your bag.
- When you have completed the assessment, you must wait until the time is up.
- Your device will be monitored throughout the exam using Classroom. Cloud. Any malpractice will mean you recomplete the assessment during a 60-minute detention.
- You need to go to the toilet at break or lunch time and will not be allowed to go throughout the assessment (unless you have a medical toilet pass).
- If you are late for the assessment, you may lose vital time or you will have to re-sit the assessment.

Equipment Required:

- Fully charged device
- Wired headphones
- Transparent water bottle (optional)

Year 7 Bridge Parents Only:

Students that study in The Bridge will also complete the GL Assessments throughout the week. However, they will not complete the assessment in the Sports Hall, they will complete the assessment in their usual environment. Students will still need the equipment listed above.
