Dear Parents/Carers,

2 weeks down, 2.5 to go! I have been very proud of the conduct and resilience of our Year 11s this past fortnight. I cannot wait to celebrate these efforts with them at the Leavers Assembly, Prom and Results Day.

Half-Term Workshops

Once again, we are in the fortunate position of being able to offer Revision workshops over half-term. These have been extremely well attended this year and I know you will support the school by encouraging your child to attend this time too.

History Revision, 10:00-12:00, Tuesday 27th May. Maths Revision, 10:00-12:00, Wednesday 28th May. Further Maths Revision, 10:00-12:00, Friday 30th May.

All sessions will be based on the first floor of the Aspire building, students need to arrive via the St Mary's gate where they will be met by teachers and escorted to classrooms.

Adjusted Timetable

From the end of the Physics Exam on 16th June, all year 11 students will be on an adjusted timetable. This means that outside of revision sessions and exams they will not need to be in school and will be able to sign out in order to study at home.

Between now and the 16th June, students should be attending a normal school day. Any student leaving school before this date for an appointment of any kind will need to evidence this to the attendance team.

<u>Eid</u>

I am aware that we are approaching Eid and that students will be celebrating this with their families. A reminder that unfortunately religious celebrations are not seen as a reason to miss an exam and that any markings on hands or arms; such as henna, will mean that students will be unable to enter the exam hall.

End of year Celebrations

Leavers Assembly: Leavers assembly will take place on Friday 20th June from 10:00-11:20. Students attending will need to be in full uniform and enter via the fire exit doors of the main hall.

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Prom: The students are getting excited for Prom and over half of tickets have now sold. If your child has had a letter inviting them, please buy their ticket via PlusPay ASAP in order to not be disappointed.

Results Day: Results Day this year is 21st August. The school will be open for students to collect their results 9:00-11:00.

Returning resources

I am sure that your child has a mountain of revision guides and workbooks. If they are able to bring these in before they leave school, they will be gratefully received as we will reuse them with the next year group. Likewise, if they have any spare uniform (particularly ties and blazers) please ask them to bring them in for the leavers assembly and we will ensure they are put to good use.
