Dear Parents/Carers,

You are warmly invited to attend the Year 11 Progress Evening on **Wednesday 25th March 2026, from 3:40pm to 6:30pm**. Bookings are now open.

This event provides a final opportunity for you, as your child's guardian, to collect their mock examination results and meet with their subject teachers. Teachers will share your child's strengths and key areas for improvement, helping you understand how best to support their revision in these crucial final weeks.

Students are to attend in full school uniform. Please notify the school if you are unable to attend, as we would very much like to make alternative arrangements to have this conversation with you too.

To streamline the booking process, we are once again using the Arbor Parent app. This app allows you to easily schedule appointments, view your child's progress, and stay updated with school communications.

Steps to Download and Use the Arbor Parent App:

- 1. Set up an account:** To set up your account, you just need to set a password. You can do this by going to the-portsmouth-academy.uk.arbor.sc, clicking on 'Forgotten Password?' and following the instructions on screen. (When first setting up your account in Arbor always use an internet browser first, this is especially important if you are already using Arbor for another child or school). Your username is your email address that we have on registered on the system.
- 2. Download the App:** You can download the App from the 'Apple App Store' or 'Google Play Store' by searching for '**Arbor Parent App**'.
- 3. Book Meetings:** Navigate to the 'Bookings' section within the app. Here, you will be able to select the available time slots for your meetings with teachers.

By attending this Progress Evening, you are supporting your child at a very important time. Their exams are only a few weeks away.
